<p>Realized Weather-Country Reports (26 Jan.-01 Feb. 24)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The western Himalayan region as a whole experienced light to moderate snow and rain. ▪ Bhutan and Nepal experienced scattered light rain and light snow over the northern and high-altitude areas. ▪ Northern parts of Pakistan experienced scattered snow and rain with the remaining parts of the country experiencing dry weather conditions. ▪ While Myanmar experienced isolated to fairly widespread rain/thundershowers mainly over its northern and southern parts, Maldives experienced mainly fair weather conditions with scattered rain/thundershowers over some places. 	
<p>Significant Weather Features in the region for coming week (02-08 Feb. 24)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A westerly trough persisting over Bhutan and adjoining areas. ▪ A westerly circulation likely to affect Afghanistan and Pakistan regions. ▪ A western disturbance likely to affect western Himalayan regions and neighbourhoods. 	
<p>Weather Outlook (02-08 Feb. 24)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Pakistan likely to experience snow/rain over its northern region and isolated rain over some places. ▪ Bhutan and Nepal likely to experience light/moderate rain/snow over the northern and high hilly places with rain over some isolated places. ▪ Bangladesh and Myanmar likely to experience scattered light rain over some places with rest of the countries likely to experience dry weather conditions. ▪ Maldives and Sri Lanka likely to experience light/moderate scattered rain/thundershowers. 	<p>Extended Range Outlook (until 15 February 2024)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Much of South Asia is likely to experience dry weather conditions towards the week ending of 15 February.
