Discussion Notes

Realized Weather- Country Reports (02-08 Feb. 24)	 The Himalayan region as a whole experienced light to moderate snow and rain during the week. Bhutan and Nepal experienced scattered light rain over some isolated places with light/moderate snow over the northern and high-altitude areas. While Myanmar experienced isolated to fairly widespread rain/thundershowers mainly over its northern region, Maldives experienced mostly fair weather with scattered rain over some places. 	
Significant Weather Features in the region for coming week (09-15 Feb. 24)	 No major synoptic features over the week. A weak trough/cyclonic circulation persisting over the Arabian Sea and a trough/circulation likely to prevail over central India. A westerly circulation likely to affect Afghanistan and Pakistan regions. Localized troughs/circulations likely to affect the Himalayan region and neighbourhoods. 	
Weather Outlook (09-15 Feb. 24)	 Pakistan likely to experience mainly dry weather conditions with snow/rain over some highland areas. Bhutan and Nepal likely to experience mainly dry and cold weather conditions with scattered light/moderate rain/snow over the northern and high hilly places with rain over some isolated places. Bangladesh and Myanmar likely to experience mainly dry weather conditions. Maldives and Sri Lanka likely to experience scattered light/moderate rain/thundershowers over some places. 	Extended Range Outlook (until 21 February 2024) Western Himalayan region including highland areas of Bhutan, Nepal and northeast India likely to experience rain/snow with rest of the South Asia likely to experience dry spells towards the week ending of 21 February.
Ocean Watch	Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (02-08 Feb. 24) No significant events reported during the week. Forecast for the coming week (09-15 Feb. 24) While mostly normal sea conditions likely to prevail, coastal areas of Maldives likely to experience intermittent rough seas over the week.
