Discussion Notes

Realized Weather- Country Reports (08-14 Mar. 24)	 Pakistan experienced light/moderate snow and rain over some places in the northern region. Bhutan and Nepal experienced cloudy weather conditions with light scattered rain/snow over isolated high lands and hilly areas. Much of Myanmar experienced dry weather conditions with scattered rain/thundershowers over isolated places in the northern and southern parts of the country. Much of Maldives experienced fair weather conditions with some places experiencing isolated rain/thunderstorms. 	
Significant Weather Features in the region for the coming week (15-21 Mar. 24)	 A feeble Western Disturbance likely to prevail over the western Himalayan region and adjoining areas. Westerly trough persisting over the Tibetan plateau and neighbourhoods. No significant synoptic phenomena over the week. 	
Weather Outlook (15-21 Mar. 24)	 Pakistan is likely to experience light scattered rain/snow over some places in the northern region. While Bhutan is likely to experience cloudy weather conditions with scattered light rain/snow over the northern and high hilly places with rain over some isolated places, much of Nepal is likely to experience dry weather conditions. Much of Bangladesh and Myanmar are likely to experience dry weather conditions with isolated rain/thundershowers over some places. Maldives and Sri Lanka are likely to experience scattered rain/thundershowers over some places with much of the countries likely to experience fair weather conditions. 	Extended Range Outlook (until 27 March 2024) Probability of rain(>25mm) likely over the western Himalayas, northeast India and southern belt of Bhutan towards the week ending of 27 March.
Ocean Watch	Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (08-14 Mar. 24) No significant events were reported during the week. Forecast for the coming week (15-21 Mar. 24) Normal sea conditions are likely to prevail over the week.
