<p>Realized Weather-Country Reports (08-14 Mar. 24)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Pakistan experienced light/moderate snow and rain over some places in the northern region. ▪ Bhutan and Nepal experienced cloudy weather conditions with light scattered rain/snow over isolated high lands and hilly areas. ▪ Much of Myanmar experienced dry weather conditions with scattered rain/thundershowers over isolated places in the northern and southern parts of the country. ▪ Much of Maldives experienced fair weather conditions with some places experiencing isolated rain/thunderstorms. 	
<p>Significant Weather Features in the region for the coming week (15-21 Mar. 24)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A feeble Western Disturbance likely to prevail over the western Himalayan region and adjoining areas. ▪ Westerly trough persisting over the Tibetan plateau and neighbourhoods. ▪ No significant synoptic phenomena over the week. 	
<p>Weather Outlook (15-21 Mar. 24)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Pakistan is likely to experience light scattered rain/snow over some places in the northern region. ▪ While Bhutan is likely to experience cloudy weather conditions with scattered light rain/snow over the northern and high hilly places with rain over some isolated places, much of Nepal is likely to experience dry weather conditions. ▪ Much of Bangladesh and Myanmar are likely to experience dry weather conditions with isolated rain/thundershowers over some places. ▪ Maldives and Sri Lanka are likely to experience scattered rain/thundershowers over some places with much of the countries likely to experience fair weather conditions. 	<p>Extended Range Outlook (until 27 March 2024)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Probability of rain(>25mm) likely over the western Himalayas, northeast India and southern belt of Bhutan towards the week ending of 27 March.
<p>Ocean Watch</p>	<p>Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (08-14 Mar. 24)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ No significant events were reported during the week. <p>Forecast for the coming week (15-21 Mar. 24)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Normal sea conditions are likely to prevail over the week.
