Discussion Notes

Realized Weather- Country Reports (22-28 Mar. 24)	 Bhutan experienced light/moderate rain over much of the country with light/moderate rain/snow over the higher altitude areas. Nepal experienced light/moderate rain/thundershowers mainly in the central and southeastern region with hilly areas in the country experiencing isolated snow. Myanmar experienced widespread rain/thundershowers over the northern region with isolated rain/thundershowers over the rest of the country. Much of Bangladesh experienced widespread rain/thundershowers with isolated heavy rain/thundershowers over some places. Maldives experienced mostly dry weather conditions with increasing day temperatures up to 45°C in some places. However, central, and southern parts of the country and some isolated places experienced rain/thundershowers with intermittent heavy rain towards the end of the week. 	
Significant Weather Features in the region for the coming week (29 Mar04 Apr. 24)	 Westerly trough persisting over Afghanistan, Pakistan, and adjoining areas. A cyclonic circulation lies over Bihar and another over south Assam in lower tropospheric levels. Westerly trough prevailing over the Tibetan plateau and neighbourhoods. Convective systems likely to persist over Maldives and adjoining areas. 	
Weather Outlook (29 Mar04 Apr. 24)	 Pakistan likely to experience widespread rain/snow over its northern region with scattered rain/thundershowers over the rest of the country. Bhutan likely to experience cloudy weather conditions with widespread rain/snow over the northern and high hilly places with rain over some low lying areas. Nepal likely to experience light/moderate rain over the southeastern and isolated parts of country. Also, isolated snow is likely over the hilly places in the southeastern region. While widespread light/moderate rain/thundershowers are likely over the northeastern parts of Bangladesh, rest of the country is likely to experience scattered rain/thundershowers with increasing day temperatures. Widespread rain/thundershowers likely 	 Extended Range Outlook (until 10 April 2024) Probability of rain(>25mm) likely over Bhutan, northeastern Bangladesh and India, northern Pakistan and isolated places in Nepal and Sri Lanka towards the week ending of 10 April.

	 over the northern parts of Myanmar with isolated rain/thundershowers over the rest of country. Maldives and Sri Lanka likely to experience scattered rain/thundershowers with isolated heavy showers over some places. 	
Ocean Watch	 Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (22-28 Mar. 24) No significant events were reported during the week. Forecast for the coming week (29 Mar04 Apr. 24) Normal sea conditions are likely to prevail over the week.
