| Realized Weather-<br>Country Reports<br>(22-28 Mar. 24)                                    | <ul> <li>Bhutan experienced light/moderate rain over much of the country with light/moderate rain/snow over the higher altitude areas.</li> <li>Nepal experienced light/moderate rain/thundershowers mainly in the central and southeastern region with hilly areas in the country experiencing isolated snow.</li> <li>Myanmar experienced widespread rain/thundershowers over the northern region with isolated rain/thundershowers over the rest of the country.</li> <li>Much of Bangladesh experienced widespread rain/thundershowers with isolated heavy rain/thundershowers over some places.</li> <li>Maldives experienced mostly dry weather conditions with increasing day temperatures up to 45°C in some places. However, central, and southern parts of the country and some isolated places experienced rain/thundershowers with intermittent heavy rain towards the end of the week.</li> </ul> |  |

| Significant Weather<br>Features in the region for<br>the coming week<br>(29 Mar04 Apr. 24) | <ul> <li>Westerly trough persisting over Afghanistan, Pakistan, and adjoining areas.</li> <li>A cyclonic circulation lies over Bihar and another over south Assam in lower tropospheric levels.</li> <li>Westerly trough prevailing over the Tibetan plateau and neighbourhoods.</li> <li>Convective systems likely to persist over Maldives and adjoining areas.</li> </ul>   |  |
| Weather Outlook<br>(29 Mar04 Apr. 24)  | <ul> <li>Pakistan likely to experience widespread rain/snow over its northern region with scattered rain/thundershowers over the rest of the country.</li> <li>Bhutan likely to experience cloudy weather conditions with widespread rain/snow over the northern and high hilly places with rain over some low lying areas.</li> <li>Nepal likely to experience light/moderate rain over the southeastern and isolated parts of country. Also, isolated snow is likely over the hilly places in the southeastern region.</li> <li>While widespread light/moderate rain/thundershowers are likely over the northeastern parts of Bangladesh, rest of the country is likely to experience scattered rain/thundershowers with increasing day temperatures.</li> <li>Widespread rain/thundershowers likely</li> </ul>  | <ul> <li>Extended Range Outlook (until 10<br/>April 2024)</li> <li>Probability of rain(&gt;25mm)<br/>likely over Bhutan,<br/>northeastern Bangladesh and<br/>India, northern Pakistan and<br/>isolated places in Nepal and Sri<br/>Lanka towards the week<br/>ending of 10 April.</li> </ul> |
