## **Discussion Notes**

Realized Weather- Country Reports (29 Mar04 Apr. 24)	<ul> <li>Bangladesh experienced light/moderate with isolated heavy rain/thundershowers predominantly in its northeastern region. Some parts of the country experienced mild heat wave conditions with the highest temperature of the week reaching at 39.6°C.</li> <li>Bhutan experienced light/moderate rain mainly in the southern and southeastern part of the country with rest of the country experiencing scattered rain and gusty winds in the afternoons.</li> <li>Nepal experienced light/moderate rain/thundershowers mainly in the hilly regions. Day temperatures rose, with the highest temperature of the week reaching 38.2°C.</li> <li>Myanmar experienced isolated rain/thundershowers mainly in the northern region, while Maldives experienced scattered rain/thunderstorms. Both countries saw daytime temperatures rising over 35°C in some places.</li> <li>In Pakistan, scattered and isolated rain occurred in the northern parts, while other regions experienced dry weather conditions alongside increasing daytime temperatures.</li> </ul>	
Significant Weather Features in the region for the coming week (05-11 Apr. 24)	A western disturbance is expected to influence northern Pakistan and surrounding areas.  The cyclonic circulation over northern Bangladesh continues, while another cyclonic circulation is present over eastern Assam and neighbouring regions in the lower tropospheric levels.  Convective systems are expected to persist over the Maldives and adjacent areas.  No significant synoptic phenomena are anticipated in any part of the region.	
Weather Outlook (05-11 Apr. 24)	<ul> <li>Pakistan is likely to experience scattered rain/thundershower mainly in the northern region, with rest of the country likely to experience dry weather conditions.</li> <li>Bhutan likely to experience cloudy weather conditions with scattered rain in some places, with gusty afternoons.</li> <li>Nepal likely to experience light/moderate rain and thunderstorms in some places.</li> <li>Light/moderate rain/thundershowers are likely in the northeastern parts of Bangladesh, while the rest of the country is expected to experience rising daytime temperatures.</li> </ul>	Extended Range Outlook (until 17 April 2024)  Probability of rain(>25mm) likely over Bhutan, northeast Bangladesh, northern Nepal, northeast India and northern Pakistan towards the week ending of 17 April.

	<ul> <li>Much of Myanmar likely to experience dry weather conditions, with scattered rain/thundershowers in some places.</li> <li>Maldives and Sri Lanka likely to experience scattered rain/thundershowers with isolated heavy showers over some places.</li> </ul>	
Ocean Watch	<ul> <li>Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (29 Mar04 Apr. 24)</li> <li>No significant events were reported during the week, except for rough sea conditions reported over the Kerala coast.</li> <li>Forecast for the coming week (05-11 Apr. 24)</li> <li>Normal sea conditions are expected to prevail throughout the week, with occasional instances of rough seas.</li> </ul>
