## **Discussion Notes**

Realized Weather- Country Reports (05-11 Apr. 24)	<ul> <li>Bhutan experienced scattered light/moderate rain in some with isolated snow in the highlands. Additionally, severe hailstorms were reported in some places.</li> <li>Nepal experienced isolated rain/thundershowers mainly in the hilly regions. The country also recorded increase in both maximum and minimum temperatures.</li> <li>In the Maldives, scattered rain and thunderstorms were observed, accompanied by occasional heavy showers in some places. The northern Atolls recorded the week's highest daytime temperature at 35°C.</li> </ul>	
Significant Weather Features in the region for the coming week (12-18 Apr. 24)	<ul> <li>A western disturbance is expected influence the most parts of the Himalayan region.</li> <li>Convective systems are expected to persist over the Maldives and adjacent areas.</li> <li>No significant synoptic phenomena are anticipated in any part of the region.</li> </ul>	
Weather Outlook (12-18 Apr. 24)	<ul> <li>Pakistan is likely to experience widespread rain/thundershowers mainly in the northern regio, with rest of the country likely to experience dry weather conditions with increase daytime temperatures.</li> <li>Bhutan likely to experience cloudy weather conditions with scattered to isolated rain/thunderstorms in some places, with gusty afternoons.</li> <li>Nepal likely to experience scattered light/moderate rain and thunderstorms in some places.</li> <li>Scattered rain/thundershowers are likely in Bangladesh. The daytime temperatures are likely to increase across much of the country.</li> <li>Much of Myanmar likely to experience dry weather conditions with increase in daytime temperatures, with scattered rain/thundershowers in some places.</li> <li>Maldives and Sri Lanka likely to experience scattered rain/thundershowers with isolated heavy showers over some places.</li> </ul>	Extended Range Outlook (until 24 April 2024) Probability of rain(>25mm) likely over Bhutan, northeast India and isolated pockets of Bangladesh, Pakistan, Sri Lanka and Maldives towards the week ending of 24 April.

	<ul> <li>Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (05-11 Apr. 24)</li> <li>No significant events were reported apart from rough sea conditions observed along the Indian coast and its surrounding areas.</li> <li>Forecast for the coming week (12-18 Apr. 24)</li> <li>Swell wave periods and heights are expected to increase over the week, potentially leading to rough seas along the coastlines of Maldives, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, and surrounding regions.</li> </ul>
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
