## **Discussion Notes**

Realized Weather- Country Reports (14-20 June 24)	<ul> <li>Bangladesh experienced moderate to heavy to very heavy rain and thundershowers mainly in the northern and southeastern regions, causing floods, due to the influence of moderate to active monsoon currents.</li> <li>In Bhutan, moderate to active monsoon currents resulted in widespread light to moderate rain across much of the country, with heavy to very heavy rain in the southern region.</li> <li>The Maldives experienced scattered rain and thundershowers, while Myanmar observed widespread light to moderate rain and thundershowers, with isolated heavy rain in some areas.</li> <li>The southeastern region of Nepal experienced light to moderate rain with isolated heavy showers, whereas the rest of the country experienced below-normal rainfall.</li> <li>The southwestern region of Sri Lanka observed moderate to heavy rain and thundershowers, while the rest of the country experienced scattered rain and afternoon thunderstorms.</li> </ul>	
Significant Weather Features in the region for the coming week (21-27 June 24)	<ul> <li>A cyclonic circulation is prevailing over northeast Bangladesh and adjacent areas with strong south-westerly to southerly winds are prevailing from the Bay of Bengal to northeast India at lower tropospheric levels.</li> <li>Conditions are favourable for the northward advancement of the southwest monsoon.</li> <li>A western disturbance is likely to prevail as cyclonic circulation over northern Pakistan and neighbouring areas.</li> </ul>	
Weather Outlook (21-27 June 24)	<ul> <li>Widespread light to moderate rain is likely across much of Bangladesh, with heavy to very heavy rain and thunderstorms in the northern and southeastern regions.</li> <li>Bhutan is expected to experience scattered light to moderate rain and thundershowers, with moderate to heavy rainfall mainly in the southern regions.</li> <li>The Maldives and Sri Lanka are likely to experience widespread rain and thundershowers, with isolated heavy rainfall.</li> <li>Widespread rain and thundershowers are expected over much of Myanmar, with isolated heavy rainfall in some areas.</li> <li>Nepal is likely to experience scattered light to moderate rain and thunderstorms, with moderate to heavy rain mainly in the</li> </ul>	Extended Range Outlook (until 03 July 2024)  • A higher probability of rain (>25mm) likely over Bhutan, Bangladesh, Myanmar, Nepal and, north and northeast India towards the week ending of 03 July.
