Discussion Notes

Realized Weather- Country Reports (21-27 June 24)	 Bangladesh experienced light to moderate rain and thundershowers with some isolated places experiencing mild heat wave conditions. Bhutan experienced mainly cloudy conditions with scattered light to moderate rain over much of the country, with isolated heavy rain in some places. Maldives experienced scattered rain and thundershowers, while Myanmar observed widespread light to moderate rain and thundershowers, with isolated heavy rain in some areas. Nepal experienced light to moderate rain over much of the country with isolated heavy showers in some places. Pakistan experienced scattered light to moderate rain and thundershowers over much of the country. The southwestern region of Sri Lanka observed moderate to heavy rain and thundershowers, while the rest of the country experienced scattered rain and thunderstorms.
Significant Weather Features in the region for the coming week (28-June-04 July 24)	 Large scale dynamical monsoon trough is deepening over central and adjoining Gangetic Plains of India and neighbourhoods. A Western Disturbance as a trough in middle tropospheric westerlies runs roughly along Long. 64°E to the north of Lat. 28°N. A cyclonic circulation lies over northwest Rajasthan and another over east Assam in the lower tropospheric levels. Strong southerly/south-westerly winds prevail in the lower tropospheric levels from the Bay of Bengal into east and northeast India. A western disturbance is likely to prevail as cyclonic circulation over the western Himalayas and neighbouring areas.
Weather Outlook (28 June-04 July 24)	 Widespread moderate to heavy rain is likely across much of Bangladesh, with heavy to very heavy rain and thunderstorms in several places. Bhutan is expected to experience scattered light to moderate rain and thundershowers, with moderate to heavy rainfall mainly in the southern regions. While Maldives is likely to experience light scattered showers, Sri Lanka is likely to experience widespread rain and thundershowers, with isolated heavy rainfall. Widespread rain and thundershowers are expected over much of Myanmar, with isolated heavy rainfall in some areas. Much of Nepal is likely to experience scattered light to moderate rain and thunderstorms, while moderate to heavy rain is likely in some isolated places. Pakistan is expected to experience scattered light to moderate rain and thundershowers with isolated heavy rainfall.

Ocean Watch	 Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (21-27 June 24) No significant events were reported. Forecast for the coming week (28 June-04 July 24) Rough seas and high waves expected mainly along the coastal areas of Pakistan and western India.
