Discussion Notes

Realized Weather- Country Reports (02-08 Aug. 24)	 Bhutan experienced cloudy conditions with widespread light to moderate rain across much of the country with isolated heavy rainfall in some areas. Maldives experienced scattered rain and thundershowers, while Myanmar had scattered to widespread rain and thundershowers across much of the country, with isolated heavy rainfall in some regions. Nepal observed mostly cloudy weather with light to moderate rain across much of the country, and isolated heavy to very heavy rain in some areas. Pakistan experienced scattered rain and thundershowers, mainly in the northern and southern regions. Sri Lanka experienced scattered thundershowers mainly in the southwestern region, with isolated heavy showers in the north-central province, and evening thundershowers across much of the country.
Significant Weather Features in the region for the coming week (09-15 Aug. 24)	 The Monsoon trough is active and positioned north of its normal position. It is likely to remain near its normal position during most days of the week. A cyclonic circulation prevailing over Gangetic West Bengal and adjoining areas. Convective systems persisting across much of the foothills of the Himalayas.
Weather Outlook (09-15 Aug. 24)	 Widespread light to moderate rain is likely over much of Bangladesh, with isolated heavy rain and thunderstorms in some places. Much of Bhutan likely to experience scattered rain and thundershowers, with moderate to heavy rain in some places. Maldives is likely to experience scattered rain and thundershowers with occasional heavy rainfall. Widespread rain and thundershowers are likely over much of Myanmar, with isolated heavy rain in some areas. Much of Nepal is likely to experience scattered light to moderate rain and thunderstorms, with isolated heavy rain in some places. Sri Lanka is likely to experience scattered rain and thundershowers, with moderate to isolated heavy rain in some places. Pakistan is likely to experience scattered light to moderate rain and thundershowers.
Ocean Watch	 Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (02-08 Aug. 24) No significant events were reported. Forecast for the coming week (09-15 Aug. 24) Rough seas are likely along the coastal areas over the week.
