Discussion Notes

Realized Weather-Country Reports (13 Sep- 19 Sep. 24)	 Much of Bhutan experienced partly cloudy weather with light rainfall except southern region which receiver scattered heavy rainfall in the lastweek. Whereas Myanmar experienced isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall over the northwestern and southeastern regions. Much of Nepal experienced partly cloudy weather with light to moderate rainfall and isolated heavy rainfall with thunderstorms and lightning in some hilly regions. While most of Maldives experienced scattered light to moderate rainfall with thunderstorms over central and southern regions. Much of Sri Lanka received several spells of scattered thundershowers and above normal temperature over the eastern and northcentral part of the country. Pakistan experienced isolated light to moderate rainfall with thunderstorm over the northeastern region.
Significant Weather Features in the region for the coming week (20 -26 Sep. 24)	 The monsoon trough is currently active and remains near its normal position during most days of the week. The current circulation at the foothills of the Himalayan region is expected to weaken. A low-pressure area near the north of the Bay of Bengal is expected to move west north-westward and crossing east coast of India producing heavy rainfall.
Weather Outlook (20 -26 Sep. 24)	 Much of Bhutan is likely to experience partly cloudy weather with light rainfall inmost of the places. Scattered rainfall and thunderstorms are likely over much of the places of Myanmar. Much of Nepal is likely to experience partly cloudy weather with isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall and thunderstorms. Maldives is likely to experience normal weather with isolated heavy rainfall in the south western provinces of the country. Pakistan is likely to experience scattered rainfall and thundershowers over central and northern region of the country.
