### Discussion Notes

<p><b>Realized Weather-Country Reports (13 Sep- 19 Sep. 24)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Much of Bhutan experienced partly cloudy weather with light rainfall except southern region which receiver scattered heavy rainfall in the lastweek.</li> <li>▪ Whereas Myanmar experienced isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall over the northwestern and southeastern regions.</li> <li>▪ Much of Nepal experienced partly cloudy weather with light to moderate rainfall and isolated heavy rainfall with thunderstorms and lightning in some hilly regions.</li> <li>▪ While most of Maldives experienced scattered light to moderate rainfall with thunderstorms over central and southern regions.</li> <li>▪ Much of Sri Lanka received several spells of scattered thundershowers and above normal temperature over the eastern and northcentral part of the country.</li> <li>▪ Pakistan experienced isolated light to moderate rainfall with thunderstorm over the northeastern region.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Significant Weather Features in the region for the coming week (20 -26 Sep. 24)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The monsoon trough is currently active and remains near its normal position during most days of the week.</li> <li>▪ The current circulation at the foothills of the Himalayan region is expected to weaken.</li> <li>▪ A low-pressure area near the north of the Bay of Bengal is expected to move west north-westward and crossing east coast of India producing heavy rainfall.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Weather Outlook (20 -26 Sep. 24)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Much of Bhutan is likely to experience partly cloudy weather with light rainfall in most of the places.</li> <li>▪ Scattered rainfall and thunderstorms are likely over much of the places of Myanmar.</li> <li>▪ Much of Nepal is likely to experience partly cloudy weather with isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall and thunderstorms.</li> <li>▪ Maldives is likely to experience normal weather with isolated heavy rainfall in the south western provinces of the country.</li> <li>▪ Pakistan is likely to experience scattered rainfall and thundershowers over central and northern region of the country.</li> </ul>
