Discussion Notes

Realized Weather- Country Reports (11 - 17 Oct. 24)	 Much of Bhutan experienced partly cloudy with fair weather. Whereas Bangladesh experienced less rainfall over the country due to the withdrawal of monsoon. Much of Nepal experienced cloudy weather with less rainfall and a few isolated thundershowers. While most of Sri Lanka experienced scattered heavy rainfall with thunderstorms and gusty wind over the southwestern part of the country. A heavy to very heavy rainfall epoch was observed over the South Indian peninsula and which caused flooding situation over many parts South India.
Significant Weather Features in the region for the coming week (18 - 24 Oct. 24)	 The monsoon withdrawal has completed from Pakistan, Bangladesh, Nepal, Bhutan and most parts of India. Due to the withdrawal of monsoon another low-pressure area near the north of the Bay of Bengal is expected to form.
Weather Outlook (18 - 24 Oct. 24)	 Much of Bhutan is likely to experience partly cloudy weather with light rainfall. Light to moderate rainfall with thundershowers is expected over most of the places of Myanmar. Much of Nepal is likely to experience cloudy weather with light rainfall and thunderstorms. Maldives is likely to experience isolated to scattered heavy rainfall over the country. Whereas Sri Lanka is likely to experience scattered heavy rainfall with afternoon thundershower over the country. Much of Bangladesh is likely to experience light to moderate rainfall with thunderstorm.
Ocean Watch	 Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (11 – 17 Oct. 24) A significant high waves and swell surge alerts have been issued for the northwestern India and Arabian Sea. Due to the low-pressure system, western part of India experienced high sea wave and coastal flooding. Forecast for the coming week (18 - 24 Oct. 24) A significant heat potential for cyclogenesis is expected in the Bay of Bengal.
	 Due to another new circulation over the Bay of Bengal, a significant wave height, and surges are expected over the coastal regions of Sri Lanka, Myanmar, West Bengal and Bangladesh over the week.
