Realized Weather-	Much of Bhutan experienced partly cloudy with isolated light rainfall.				
Country Reports	Whereas Bangladesh experienced less rainfall over the country due to the				
(18 - 24 Oct. 24)	withdrawal of monsoon.				
	 Much of Nepal experienced cloudy weather with less rainfall and a few isolated thundershowers. 				
	 Most of the Maldives experienced severe weather with scattered thundershower, 				
	gusty wind and swell surges.				
	While most part of Myanmar received light to moderate rainfall over the central and southern part of the country.				
	 Much of Sri Lanka experienced dry weather excepts a few parts of the southwestern 				
	and southern islands, which received moderate to heavy rainfall.				
	While Pakistan observed mostly dry weather except a few parts of the central which received light rainfall.				
	 Light to moderate rainfall was observed over the Southern and southwestern part of Bangladesh. 				
	 A high heat potential for BoB has been discussed in the previous session which 				
	proves that the formation and intensity of the system can be predicted a week				
	before though the landfall location may vary.				
	 The monsoon withdrawal has completed from Pakistan, Bangladesh, Nepal, 				
Significant Weather	Bhutan and most parts of India.				
Features in the region for	 West Bengal and Odisha region may get a significant amount of rainfall due to the 				
the coming week	Cyclone "DANA".

Weather Outlook	 Much of Bhutan is likely to experience partly cloudy weather with isolated light rainfall.

	 Most parts Myanmar may receive light rainfall except central, western and southern part. These areas may receive thunderstorm with gusty wind due to the 				
	remnants of the system.				
	Much of Nepal is likely to experience fair weather.				
	Maldives is likely to experience isolated to scattered heavy rainfall over the country.				
	 Whereas Sri Lanka is likely to experience scattered moderate to heavy rainfall with 				
	afternoon thundershower over the country.				
	 Much of Bangladesh is likely to experience light rainfall except the southwestern 				
	part of the country.				
Ocean Watch	Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (18 – 24 Oct. 24)				
	 A significant high waves and swell surge alerts have been issued for the northwestern 				
	India and Arabian Sea. Due to the low-pressure system, North Central Bangalore area				
	of India experienced high sea wave.				
	Forecast for the coming week (25 - 31 Oct. 24)				
	No significant heat potential for cyclogenesis is expected in the Bay of Bengal.				
	 A significant wave height, and surges are expected over the coastal regions of 				
	West Bengal and some other southwestern coastal region Bangladesh.
