Discussion Notes

Realized Weather-Country Reports (31 Oct. – 07 Nov. 24)	 Much of Bhutan experienced partly cloudy with isolated light rainfall. Whereas Bangladesh experienced no significant weather except isolated light rainfall over a few southern regions. Much of Nepal observed fair weather with isolated light rainfall with thunderstorm in some hilly regions of the country. Most of the Maldives experienced scattered heavy to very heavy rainfall over the central and northern areas of the country with thunderstorm. While dry weather persisted over most of the Pakistan moderate rainfall. Most of the Sri Lanka experienced mostly heavy to very heavy evening rainfall with thunderstorm all over the country.
Significant Weather Features in the region forthe coming week (08 – 14 Nov. 24)	 An essential phenomena of mid latitude westerly trough and tropical circulation interaction, particularly northeast monsoon circulation may persist over BoB. And on the other hand, a strong westerly may dominant over the north Indian peninsula. A cyclonic circulation may develop in the southern hemisphere which may cause gusty wind and swell surge over Maldives.
Weather Outlook (08 - 14 Nov. 24)	 Much of Bhutan is likely to experience no significant weather except a few degrees of temperature dropping. South and Southeastern parts of Myanmar may receive light to moderate rainfall with thunderstorm and gusty wind due to the remnants of the easterlies system in the Bay of Bengal. Much of Nepal is likely to experience fair weather. Maldives is likely to experience isolated to scattered heavy rainfall and evening thunderstorms over the country. Whereas Sri Lanka is likely to experience scattered moderate to heavy rainfall with afternoon thundershower over the country. Much of Bangladesh is likely to experience no rainfall except temperature dropping.
Ocean Watch	 Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (31 Oct. – 07 Nov. 24) No significant high waves and swell surge observed over the coastal regions of West Bengal, Bangladesh and Myanmar except Sri Lanka and Maldives due to active northeastern monsoon. Forecast for the coming week (08 – 14 Nov. 24) No significant heat potential for cyclogenesis is expected in the Bay of Bengal. No significant wave height, and surges are expected over the coastal regions of Odisha, West Bengal and some other southwestern coastal region Bangladesh except a few coastal regions of Sri Lanka and Maldives.
