Discussion Notes

Realized Weather (31 Mar06 Apr. 23)	 Much of Pakistan experienced good amount of rain/thundershowers with some places experiencing heavy rain/ thundershowers. Bhutan and Nepal experienced isolated rain/snow in their northern regions and rain/thunderstorms over the rest of the countries with heavy thundershowers in some isolated places. While much of Bangladesh experienced isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers, some places experienced isolated heavy rain/thundershowers. Myanmar experienced isolated to widespread rain/thundershowers across much of the country. Maldives and Sri Lanka experienced isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers with isolated places of Sri Lanka experiencing heavy thundershowers. 	
Salient synoptic features in the coming week (07- 13 Apr. 23)	 Westerly waves likely to continue over Pakistan until 10 April 2023, thereafter dry continental air likely to prevail over the country. A shallow western disturbance likely to continue over Bhutan and Nepal. Anticyclonic flow to prevail over Bangladesh and adjoining areas. Moderate north easterly and south easterly winds likely over south with equatorial circulations over extreme south of Myanmar and possibility of a weak WD over its northern region. North easterly and south easterly winds likely to pass over Maldives and Sri Lanka. Also, shallow easterly waves likely to pass over south of Sri Lanka. 	
Rainfall outlook (07-13 Apr. 23)	 Isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers likely over the northern region of Pakistan with rest of the country likely to remain dry. Isolated rain/snow likely over Bhutan and Nepal. Bangladesh to experience mainly dry conditions with intermittent isolated rain/thundershowers. Also, isolated rain/thundershowers expected over southern and northern Myanmar. Possibility of isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers over Maldives and Sri Lanka with intermittent isolated heavy thunderstorms over some places. 	 Extended Range Outlook (until 19 April 2023) Higher probability of rain/snow (>25mm) over Bhutan, northern Pakistan and northeast India towards the week ending of 19 April 2023.

Temperature outlook (07-13 Apr. 23)	 No significant anomalies. 	Ocean Watch Ocean Surface Forecast briefing during past week (31 Mar06 Apr. 23) No significant events were observed. Forecast for coming week (07-13 Apr. 23) No significant events over the week.
