Discussion Notes

Realized Weather (19-25 May 23)	 While northern and central parts of Pakistan experienced isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers, rest of country experienced dry conditions. Bhutan and Nepal experienced light to moderate rain with isolated thunderstorms over some places. Also, Bangladesh experienced isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers with intermittent heavy thundershowers in some places. Maldives, Myanmar, and Sri Lanka mainly experienced isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers. 	
Salient synoptic features in the coming week (26 May- 01 June 23)	 Westerly waves are likely to affect northern parts of Pakistan. Western disturbance is likely to continue over Bhutan and Nepal regions. A trough extended from sub-Himalayan West Bengal to east Bangladesh likely to persist. Westerly trough likely to pass over northern Myanmar with moderate to strong cross equatorial flow over the southern region from 28 May 2023. North-south trough from Tamil Nadu to west of Sri Lanka likely to persist. While weak to moderate cross equatorial flow is likely over Arabian sea, moderate to strong cross equatorial flow is likely over Bay of Bengal from 28 May 2023. 	
Rainfall outlook (26 May-01 June 23)	 Under the influence of the above synoptic situations, countries are likely to experience the following weather conditions. With isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers over its northern region, much of Pakistan is likely to experience hot and dry weather conditions. Isolated rain/thundershowers are likely over Bhutan and Nepal. Also, isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers with intermittent heavy thundershowers likely over Bangladesh. Isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers likely over Myanmar with increase in rainfall activity likely over its southern region from 28 May 2023. Isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers likely over Maldives and Sri Lanka with possibility of increase rain/thundershowers from 28 May 2023. 	 Extended Range Outlook (until 07 June 2023) Higher probability of rain (>25mm) likely over Bhutan, Maldives, isolated places of Nepal, Pakistan, Myanmar, Sri Lanka and Bangladesh towards the week ending of 07 June 2023.

Temperature outlook (26 May- 01 June 23)	 Day temperatures are likely to increase over the region with some places expected to experience significantly high temperatures. Forecast for the coming week (26 May- 01 June 23) No significant events in forecast over the week.
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
