Discussion Notes

Realized Weather (16-22 June 23)	 The northeast and lower south of Pakistan received rainfall between 40-206 mm during the week with rest of the country experiencing dry conditions. While most parts of Bhutan and Nepal experienced isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers, eastern part of Nepal experienced intermittent heavy rainfall due to the onset of southwest monsoon 2023. Bangladesh experienced isolated to widespread rain/thundershowers with heavy rain over isolated places. Maldives, Myanmar and Sri Lanka mainly experienced isolated and widespread rain/thundershowers. 	
Salient synoptic features in the coming week (23- 29 June 23)	 Westerly waves are likely to affect central and northern parts of Pakistan during the week of 25 June 2023. A westerly trough is likely to continue over Bhutan and Nepal regions. Also, monsoon easterlies are seen over northeast India and Bhutan regions at lower levels. A trough extended from sub-Himalayan West Bengal to east Bangladesh is likely to persist. A westerly trough is likely to pass over northern Myanmar with moderate to strong crossequatorial flow likely over the country. North-south trough from Tamil Nadu to the west of Sri Lanka and Maldives is likely to persist. Low pressure system is likely to form over northwest Bay of Bengal off West Bengal and Bangladesh coasts on 25 June 2023 and move west north-westerly direction. Strengthening of cross equatorial flow is likely over the Arabian Sea and the Bay of Bengal. 	
Rainfall outlook (23-29 June 23)	 Under the influence of the above synoptic situations, countries are likely to experience the following weather conditions. Isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers likely over central and northern regions of Pakistan with isolated heavy rain/thundershowers likely over the region from 25 June 2023. Isolated rain/thundershowers are likely over Bhutan and Nepal with the possibility of heavy rain/thundershowers over some places. Also, isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers are likely over Bangladesh with intermittent heavy rain. Scattered to widespread rain/thundershowers 	Extended Range Outlook (until 05 July 2023) Higher probability of rain (>25mm) is likely over Bhutan, Nepal, Bangladesh, Myanmar, eastern and western parts of India and isolated places of Maldives and Sri Lanka towards the week ending of 05 July 2023.

	are likely over Myanmar with intermittent heavy rain/thundershowers over some places. Isolated and scattered rain/thundershowers are likely over the Maldives and Sri Lanka with the possibility of isolated heavy rain after 24 June 2023.

Forecast for the coming week (23- 29 June 23) Higher waves are likely over the Arabian Sea. Rest of the region is likely to experience normal ocean conditions.
