Discussion Notes

| Realized Weather (21-27 July 23) | Under the influence of active monsoon currents and westerly waves, northern and central parts of Pakistan experienced moderate to heavy rain/thundershowers. The country recorded a weekly accumulated rainfall between 141-360 mm. While much of Bhutan and Nepal observed light to moderate rain/thundershowers with intermittent heavy rain in some places, most parts of Bangladesh experienced less rainfall with mild heat wave conditions. Except for few isolated heavy rain/thundershowers, much of Maldives experienced fair weather conditions. | |
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| Salient synoptic features in the coming week (28 July- 03 Aug. 23) | Lower pressure over Bay of Bengal and adjoining coastal areas likely to persists. Monsoon trough is likely to shift gradually to its normal position. Offshore trough is likely from Maharashtra coast to Kerala coast over mean sea level. Strengthening of the cross-equatorial flow is likely over the Arabian Sea and the Bay of Bengal. The persistence of Somali jets is likely to continue. Westerly waves and monsoon winds from the Arabian Sea are likely to continue to affect Pakistan. A westerly trough and monsoon easterlies are likely to affect Bhutan and Nepal regions. A moderate to strong monsoonal flow is likely to continue over Bangladesh, Myanmar, Maldives and Sri Lanka. | |
| Rainfall outlook (28 July-03 Aug. 23) | Under the influence of the above synoptic situations, countries are likely to experience the following weather conditions: Scattered to fairly widespread rain/thundershowers likely over Pakistan with intermittent heavy rain/thundershowers. Scattered to fairly widespread rain/thundershowers are likely over Bangladesh, Bhutan and Nepal with the intermittent moderate to heavy rain/thundershowers over some places. Scattered to fairly widespread rain/thundershowers are likely over Myanmar with possibility of intermittent heavy rain in some places. Isolated to scattered rain/thundershowers, at times fairly widespread to isolated heavy | Extended Range Outlook (until 08 August 2023) A higher probability of rain (>25mm) is likely over Bhutan, Nepal, Bangladesh, India, Myanmar, northern parts of Pakistan and isolated places over Sri Lanka and Maldives towards the week ending of 08 August. |
