## **Discussion Notes**

Realized Weather- Country Reports (08-14 Sept. 23)	<ul> <li>While much of Pakistan experienced hot and dry weather conditions, northern and central parts of the country experienced light/moderate isolated rain/thundershowers.</li> <li>Bhutan and Nepal experienced light/moderate isolated rain/thundershowers over some places with isolated heavy thundershowers in Nepal. Both countries observed increasing temperatures during the week.</li> <li>Bangladesh experienced moderate/heavy isolated rain/thundershowers mostly in its southern region with light/moderate scattered rain/thundershowers in some places of the country. Some parts of the country also experienced mild heat wave conditions during the week.</li> <li>Myanmar experienced fairly widespread to widespread rain/thundershowers with intermittent regionally heavy rainfall in some places.</li> <li>Maldives experienced light/moderate scattered rain/thundershowers with heavy rain/thundershowers over the central and southern Atolls.</li> </ul>	
Significant Weather Features in the region for coming week (15-21 Sept. 23)	<ul> <li>A Low-Pressure Area formed over the Northwest and adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal has strengthened, transforming into a Well-Marked Low-Pressure Area situated off the North Odisha-West Bengal coasts. Currently, it lies over the Northwest Bay of Bengal and the neighboring North Odisha-West Bengal coasts. Over the next two days, it is expected to traverse across the regions of Odisha and Chhattisgarh.</li> <li>The Monsoon Trough currently lies south of its normal position.</li> <li>A cyclonic circulation in the lower tropospheric levels is seen over southeastern Uttar Pradesh and the adjacent northeastern part of Madhya Pradesh.</li> <li>Shallow westerly waves likely over the northern regions of Pakistan and adjoining area.</li> </ul>	
Weather Outlook (15-21 Sept. 23)	<ul> <li>Pakistan likely to experience light/moderate rain/thundershowers with increase in rain/thundershowers expected from 16 to 20 September.</li> <li>Light/ moderate fairly widespread rain/thundershowers likely over Bangladesh, Bhutan and Nepal with isolated heavy rainfall likely over some places in Bangladesh and Nepal.</li> <li>Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rain/thundershowers likely over Myanmar with regionally heavy rainfall over some places.</li> <li>Light/moderate to isolated heavy</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Extended Range Outlook (until 27 September 2023)</li> <li>A higher probability of rainfall (&gt;25 mm) is likely over isolated places of Bangladesh, Maldives, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, India and southern parts of Bhutan and Nepal towards the week ending of 27 September.</li> </ul>

Ocean Watch	<ul> <li>Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (08-14 Sept. 23)</li> <li>No significant events were observed in the region.</li> <li>Forecast for the coming week (15-21 Sept. 23)</li> <li>High period waves likely off Sri Lanka, western Bay of Bengal, eastern Arabian Sea Bangladesh and Myanmar.</li> </ul>
