Discussion Notes

Realized Weather- Country Reports (22-28 Dec. 23)	 Bhutan and Nepal mainly experienced cold and dry weather conditions. With light scattered rain/thundershowers over some places in the northern and southern parts, much of Myanmar experienced dry weather conditions. Sri Lanka experienced light/moderate widespread rain/thundershowers over the country with intermittent heavy rain/thundershowers mainly in the eastern and southeastern parts of the country. Some places recorded more than 100 mm rain in 24 hrs. during the week. Northeast monsoon has onset over Maldives on 24 December. The country experienced widespread rain/thundershowers with its southern parts experiencing very heavy rain causing floods during the week. Northwest India and northeast Pakistan experienced intense fog conditions during the week.
Significant Weather Features in the region for coming week (29 Dec. 23-04 Jan. 24)	 Mid latitude westerly trough likely to affect western Himalayan regions over the week. Easterly troughs likely to persist over Maldives, Sri Lanka and adjoining areas. Formation of cyclonic circulation over the equatorial Arabian Sea likely over the week.
Weather Outlook (29 Dec. 23-04 Jan. 24)	 Much of Pakistan, Bhutan and Nepal likely to experience dry weather conditions with scattered light rain/snow over the northern highlands of Bhutan and Nepal. Bangladesh and Myanmar likely to experience mostly dry weather with light scattered rain/thundershowers over some isolated places in Myanmar. Maldives and Sri Lanka likely to experience widespread rain/thundershowers with isolated heavy rain over some places. Much of the South Asia region likely to experience dry weather conditions towards the week ending of 11 January.
Ocean Watch	 Observed Ocean Surface Conditions (22-28 Dec. 23) No significant events reported during the week. Forecast for the coming week (29 Dec. 23-04 Jan. 24) Except for high swell wave periods over the coasts of India, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh and Maldives, no significant events are likely over the week.
